Who?



- Superintendents

What?



- An Ed.D. in Leadership
- Known as a “professional doctorate.”

What?



- Leadership development through increased knowledge, skills and experience.
- Research knowledge and skills to assist you in being a competent creator of research and an “applied research” leader.

What?



- Support students developing the head and heart to address issues of social justice in educational settings.
- In the first two years, students take content courses and research courses.
- In the third year, students receive dissertation writing support and attend two colloquiums.

Where?



- The workplace is the student's laboratory.
- Face to face class sessions are held at CSUSM and UCSD.
- Web based class sessions.

When?



- New cohort each January – Cohort 13 will begin January 2017
- Designed to be completed in three years – typically, students take 3-4 years.
- Summers are a quarter!
- Quarter system – 36 units each quarter

When?



- Student time commitment is hefty.
- 12 months for three years and beyond, is necessary.
- Each week , 2 courses – 3 hours of class time (f2f and/or online) for each and 6 hours of preparation outside of class time for each.
- Practicums, as well.
- That is typically 18 hours a week dedicated to the program - reading, writing, thinking, engaging in class.

Why?



- Help schools move past fixing the 19th century model of education.
- Increase student learning and their preparation for the future.
- Change our educational environments so all students get a fair shot at success.
- Build a legacy of leadership that will serve our region for many years to come.

How?



- 2015-16 Program fee: \$3,260.23 per quarter
- Health Insurance: \$1138/quarter (waived if you have coverage)
- Projected cost of three year program using projected 15-16 fees without health insurance is \$39,120

Leadership Program

Comparative costs Spring 2014

- SDSU Ed.D in Educ. Leadership

- \$6206/semester, 3 years = \$43,442

- USC Ed.D in Educ. Leadership

- \$1536/unit, 3 years = \$71,343

- UCLA Ed.D in Edu. Leadership

- \$15,208.38/yr, 3 years=\$45,624

- University of Phoenix – Ed.D. in Ed. Leadership

- \$68,220


- Alliant Ed.D. in Ed Leadership & Management

- \$1,061/unit, 61 units = \$64,721

- USD Ph.D. in Ed. Leadership

- \$1320/unit; 63 units = \$83,160
